All anesthetic procedures include pre-anesthetic blood testing to ensure pets are healthy enough to undergo surgery/anesthesia. If your pet's surgery is postponed due to a condition revealed in the pre-anesthetic blood testing, you will be responsible for the cost of the blood testing at the time the abnormality is found. The preanesthetic blood testing included in the wellness plan is for the surgical procedure and is available only on the day the surgery is performed.
